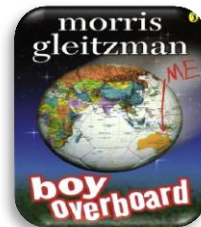


LIFE IN AFGHANISTAN RESEARCH TASK

REQUIREMENTS

Your poster needs to have a **title**, an **introduction**; this must provide some background information on the country of Afghanistan, and **3 paragraphs** of information.

For each aspect (topic) you need to write a paragraph of information. This means that you need to write 4 x paragraphs. You also need to include images (no more than 4) to support your writing.

USE THE FOLLOWING PROMPTS TO HELP WRITE YOUR RESEARCH FINDINGS.

Introduction:

- * Where is Afghanistan located?
- * What is the current population of Afghanistan?
- * How would you describe the landscape of the country?
- * What would the climate be like and how would it affect the people living there?



Role of Women:

- * Why would women not be treated as equally as men in Afghanistan?
- * What roles do women occupy in society?
- * Describe the clothing traditionally worn by women in Afghanistan and why they would have to wear it.

Children:

- * What access to education do children in Afghanistan have?
- * What activities outside of school would children in Afghanistan participate in, if any?
- * Why might children have to leave school to find work?

Asylum Seekers:

- * What is an Asylum Seeker?
- * Why might someone want to flee Afghanistan to seek a home in a new country?
- * What challenges might an Asylum Seeker face in their journey to a new country and in setting up a new life in a new country?
